Why HHW collections matter

Some household products contain chemicals that are too toxic for the trash or drain.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) collections provide a safe way for residents to dispose of these items and help protect Cape Cod's drinking water.

2026 Collection Schedule

All collections take place on Saturdays.

Location for all dates: Barnstable Transfer Station, 45 Flint Street, Marstons Mills

- April 4, 2026, 9am to Noon
- June 27, 2026, 9am to Noon
- August 29, 2026, 9am to Noon
- September 26, 2026, 9am to Noon

Bring items like:

- Leftover paints and stains
(Latex paint acceptance varies by town. Check with your town)
- Lawn and garden products
- Household cleaners and disinfectants
- Auto and boat fluids
- Pool chemicals
- Mercury-containing items like thermometers, thermostats, and barometers

Do not bring:

- Unknown or unlabeled materials
- Medical waste or sharps
