## IS MY PAINT HAZARDOUS?

If you see any of these words on the label, it's Hazardous!

Combustible, Oil, Alkyd, Petroleum Distillates, Mineral Spirits, Linseed Oil, Hydrocarbons, Solvent-based, Lacquer, Thinner, Lead, Chromium, Two-part paint, Car or Boat paint, Swimming Pool paint.

## Get Creative!

There are many ways to donate or pass-on your unused paint:

- Ask friends, family, or neighbors if they can use it.
- Donate to hobby groups like beekeepers or boatbuilders.
- Share with community groups such as drama clubs, Scouts, or shelters.
- Drop it off at your town's paint shed, open May through October.
- Remember, paint is expensive. Donating helps someone else save money.
